Overview

The functional update 3.0 system update adds new functionality to the MENUi menu system and corrects some minor program bugs. The main update is with the addition of a new menu option type. Option type *P*, or place holder, is used to reserve a menu option number for future use. This update also includes several general system bug fixes. Refer to the following table for a list of changes/updates.
