Overview

This hot fix 1.0 system update fixes the issue where a text or place holder option would appear more than once on a menu. If one of those options were marked using **F10** or the option **X**, the Menu Designer would either mark the wrong text or place holder option, or it would paste them in the wrong order using the **X**/option.

To correct the fault, a secondary field will be automatically assigned to any text or place holder options to make them unique on a menu. The mark and paste functionality will now work as expected.

This fix should only be applied to installations that have the function update 3.0 installed.

The following table lists the changes.

UPD	FU3	2010-03-19	Fixed issue with marking options in the Menu Designer. Text options and place holder options would not mark correctly. Issue only occurred if there were more than one text or place holder options with the same ID.
